- Papers will undergo a standard (but expedited) review process. You will receive an initial editorial decision of rejection or accept/revise/resubmit with detailed comments within one month. In the cases that are positive, revised drafts will be due by August 15, 2020.
- We aim to publish the special issue in the first half of 2021.
